

🛛 Inserting a disc

Insert a disc with the label side facing up. **DDX771**



DDX491HD/DDX471HD/DDX371/DDX310BT/ DDX3071BT/DDX271/DDX2071



The source changes to **"DISC"** and playback starts.

- The IN indicator lights up while a disc is inserted.
- If "\O" appears on the screen, the unit cannot accept the operation you have tried to do.
- In some cases, without showing "Q," operations will not be accepted.
- When playing back a multi-channel encoded disc, the multi-channel signals are downmixed to stereo.

🛛 Ejecting a disc

- When removing a disc, pull it horizontally.
- You can eject a disc when playing another AV source.
- If the ejected disc is not removed within 15 seconds, the disc is automatically inserted again into the loading slot to protect it from dust.

Closing the monitor panel (only for DDX771)

After removing the disc, press \blacktriangle on the monitor panel. The monitor panel closes.


